Our landscape contractor is already making great progress in adding bark mulch throughout all common areas and landscape beds in our neighborhood. Focus for the last 30 days has been on cleaning debris underneath bushes and removing/pruning shrubs to make it easy to spread bark mulch.

Second focus has been to assess any issues with the sprinkler systems and begin our summer schedule for watering on a regular basis. Richard has himself been repairing, testing and also working with our irrigation system contractor to get everything in the best shape possible. He continues to search for lines and sprinkler heads that leak or in need of repair – without any map of where they are!
