LANDSCAPE NEWS

The Landscape contract is being finalized and will be effective 1/1/2022-12/31/2022. The Board approved staying with the existing contractor Ambro's Landscaping.

Irrigation lines have been winterized and turned off for the season.

Leaves and debris have been cleaned up on all street side properties and on the back of the south side homes after the big winds! The remainder of the north side and between buildings on the north properties will be finished in the coming weeks.

Replanting of areas throughout Division 7 is now on hold until spring – planning for next year will be on the committee's agenda.

Landscape and Maintenance will be working together to resolve the very wet areas around and between buildings 117-119 and 119-121. This has been an ongoing problem for years and we hope to find permanent solutions.

REMINDER – the yard waste repository on the west island is for Division 7 yard waste only. It is a service that does cost us more each year – so please do not allow friends from outside of Division 7 to dump their yard waste in that area. Thanks!

MAINTENANCE UPDATES

- Drainage and gutters have been the focus for most of December. With help from the Landscape Directors, we are hoping to solve both downspout, gutter, and irrigation systems to ensure that water drains properly for all buildings. Gutters that need to be repaired or replaced that have been reported are on the list for repairs in early 2022 – the earliest that we can get any contractor here. We are experimenting with redirecting downspouts out away from the house instead of through the underground drainage system that appears in some cases to be inadequate. We will keep all of you informed as we assess options.
- Bids are in on the remaining 2021 projects decks and concrete work but will not be done until 2022 due to contractor schedules. We are making progress and ask for your patience while the contractors confirm the schedules for starting projects.
- Siding issues on 2 buildings are being assessed and we are waiting on bids to repair as needed.
- REMINDER if you have any issues with privacy walls, fences, gutters, or drains, please submit a service request – we cannot assess all maintenance needs if we don't get notified of problems. The Board will be reviewing the estimated costs of maintenance for the next 5 years and we would like your help to be sure we know what needs fixed!
