Editor comment: It has been sad to say goodbye to some residents who have moved or passed in the last two years, but luckily for us all, the new residents who have moved into Hilltop are busy updating and beautifying their new digs, meeting new neighbors, joining in meetings and events, energizing Hilltop with new enthusiasm for the wonderful street and area in which we live. Thank you, new residents, for engaging in our neighborhood so enthusiastically and adding to the value of our properties by enhancing and renovating your own new homes. We are so glad to have you!

#### **MAINTENANCE UPDATES**

- Maintenance is busy wrapping up 2022 projects including the drainage area (with Landscape Committee) near 117A. For now, that drainage area is dry and is being monitored by the Owner and the Landscape Committee to note when the ground becomes saturated to better assess best remedy for the swamp that occurs at times.
- We still have a pending skylight repair, and are having a great deal of difficulty finds a contractor now who will repair or reseal skylights. We thank the Owner for their patience – we will keep trying!
- Siding repairs at 126 and 108 are still pending and will probably be addressed in 2023, due to budget constraints. Bids are being sought now and we hope to secure a contractor as soon as possible, even to schedule the work in 2023.
- Last 2022 glass replacement on the schedule at 134A is going to be completed early 2023.
   Contractor has the glass, and we will delay the installation until we have budget dollars in 2023 to complete. Remainder of glass replacement requests will be rebid in 2023 when we hope glass prices fall!
- Possible damage due to a sink hole was noted in the driveway at 134A. Maintenance has sealed the cracks and is seeking bids for repairs.

#### LANDSCAPE UPDATES

- Meetings with SLOA re better year-round landscape maintenance and drainage on their property on Hilltop surrounding the pool area have been somewhat successful. Joel and Rob also discussed with Board President, John Hammond, the continued location of the large dumpster on the street besides this area not hidden per SLOA rules. Kathy Renehan, new Greenbelt Committee Chair, has agreed to have the ugly tree stumps removed from this area, if approved by SLOA, and walked the property with Rob and Carol Stults, taking a lot of notes on areas that need to be better maintained. Kathy agreed to review this with the Board, and we hope this will result in a more pleasing site for all Hilltop residents. Kathy is also going to address the parking issue, particularly troublesome when the pool is not in operation. We had the opportunity also to educate them on the property lines defining the land owned by Division 7 vs SLOA. We appreciate the quick response from John and Kathy on this issue. More updates to follow!
- Significant irrigation line leak at 121A has been repaired; additional leak at 117C has been reviewed
  and the water to that north front area has been shut off for now. Contractor will be out to provide an
  estimate for repairs, which may be done in the spring 2023, since irrigation lines will be shut down
  soon for the winter. Landscape will keep the owners of 117 affected informed of the final decision.
- Irrigation lines will be shut off as soon the rain starts.
- Ambros Landscaping is starting to prune shrubs this week, and that work will continue for several weeks. Low branch tree pruning will be tackled when all the leaves come down.
