#### **Project Updates from Julie:**

- Windows with broken seals were replaced at 108A. The replacement glass list includes all owners who have turned in requests for a review or replacement of window glass that is showing signs of broken seals. While we do not budget a great deal of dollars annually for these repairs, we keep a list that is sorted by the date Request was turned in, and the level of clouded glass that is present, and spend the annual budget accordingly. If you have a glass window whose seal has broken, please send a Request for Service from the website.
- A temporary repair was made to a wooden chimney surround at 119A that was causing a roof leak. More repairs will be necessary in the spring. We're waiting for warmer temperatures to begin work on several repairs around Hilltop!
- We are seeking bids from painters for the exterior of 138/140, and will plan to complete that full exterior project in 2025, once the weather is warmer.

#### **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS UPDATES**

Much has been written in the news about emergencies affecting homes and lives in many areas, including emergencies caused by weather (wind, snow, ice storms, heat, tornadoes, earthquakes, floods, volcano eruptions, and hurricanes), as well as significant fires.

While on the Olympic Peninsula, focus is often on the chance of a major earthquake, there are many other factors that may impact your home and lives on a smaller scale but that will prove to be as impactful to individuals financially and physically. A fire or flood in a house or condo can result in loss of a home for many months and may also pose a significant danger to life.

This month is the time to potentially review your plan for **any emergency** – your escape from the immediate danger, food and water availability, power to cook and stay warm (what is going to be your source of backup heat), and temporary housing.

The good news is that we have a significant organization in Clallam County to assist with preparedness. Here are some people to contact for access to information and guidance on what steps to take to be ready for anything that represents an emergency.
